General info

Variants: Some wicks have variants for different candle diameter.

Direction: Wicks with direction are not suitable for the drawing of candles, because the wicks only burn optimally in one direction.

Wick type: Round wicks are suitable for natural waxes.
Flat wicks are suitable for stearin and paraffin waxes.
